## Chaplain's Message

.On June 13th, Timothy Cardinal Dolan, Archbishop of New York inaugurated the first Shrine in the world dedicated to prayer for persecuted Christians, with the blessing of the icon of Our Lady of Aradin, "Mother of the Persecuted Church," at St. Michael's Church in New York City.

At the dedication, his Eminence said he hopes the shrine will be a place "to pray for all the displaced Christians of the Middle East," and for the whole world.

The new shrine showcases an icon of Our Lady of Aradin, an image of the Virgin Mary with Iraqi features, which Cardinal Dolan called "timely and relevant" adding that he hoped the sanctuary would be a place "for all who cherish religious freedom."

Few of us are truly aware how many of our brothers and sisters in Christ face extreme persecution for their Christian faith. This is particularly true in some parts of the Middle East where many Christians have become modern day martyrs.

As our nation prepares to celebrate Independence Day, let us give thanks that the laws of our nation guarantee us religious freedom. Let also be united in prayer with our Christian brothers and sisters who are denied such basic essential rites. Let us be a voice for those who are silenced because, like us, like acknowledge

Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
