# Chaplain's Message - The Sacred Heart of Jesus and Blessed Michael McGivney

July 3rd the Church celebrates the feast of St. Thomas the Apostle. We all know this famous doubting Thomas story. Jesus didn't forget that Thomas wasn't with the other disciples when he appeared to them earlier behind locked doors. He certainly didn't forget that Thomas doubted his resurrection. But Jesus didn't forget him despite those misgivings. On the contrary, Christ purposely sought him out and then greeted him with words of peace. Jesus didn't let him off the hook that easy and he will not allow us to withdraw from him so easily either. The Lord continues to this day, to seek out his own that have wandered away from him.

Did you ever wonder what your reaction would be like seeing the Lord in that way? Well, we all fall short of doubting him. And for many Catholics in the United States his real presence in the Eucharist is doubted and questioned by over 70% of Catholics! This is shocking. Jesus says "blessed are we who have not seen yet believe!"

Our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength. Jesus Christ invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith—his Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Go to Him. Adore Him. Worship Him. Trust Him. Last month on the Feast of Corpus Christi, the USCCB officially launched the revival campaign for the National Eucharistic Congress 2024 which will be held in Indianapolis. It is the voice of Christ through the Church seeking and calling each of us, despite our wandering off, to come home.

A Eucharistic Congress is gathering of clergy, religious, and laity to bear witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, which is an important Roman Catholic doctrine. The revival initiative will include the development of new teaching materials, training for diocesan and parish leaders, the launch of a dedicated revival website, and the deployment of a special team of 50 priests who will travel the country to preach about the Eucharist.

Do you believe that Jesus Christ is truly present body blood soul and divinity in the Blessed Eucharist? Even if you or someone you know has wandered from this truth, Christ is seeking you out to know Him again in the Eucharist. What an awesome time for renewal. What an awesome time for our brother Knights and sister Columbiettes to play a role in this great event. Let us help to make this not a one off but a long and lasting movement of bearing witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
